TESORO ORPHANAGE

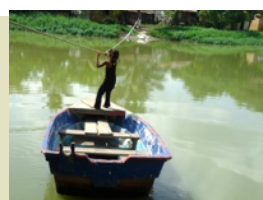
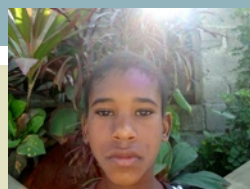
